### SHOW SECTIONS AND LIST OF CLASSES

Exhibitors may enter 2 exhibits for each class apart from the Photography Section - <u>one photo per exhibitor for each class</u>. No exhibitor may be awarded more than one prize in anyone class.

#### **COOKERY SECTION** - 18 CLASSES

Section rules: \* All jams, jellies, marmalades, and chutneys must have been made by the exhibitor since September 2023. \* Each must be displayed in a screw top jar, minimum size of jar 227gms.

- 2. Jar of Stoned Fruit Jam
- 3. Jar of any Fruit Jelly
- 4. Jar of Marmalade (any type)
- 5. Jar of Chutney (any type)
- 6. Home-made Alcoholic Spirit Drink (e.g. Sloe Gin, Blackberry Vodka, etc)
- 7. Home-made Cordial
- 8. A Carrot Cake
- 9. Loaf of Tea Bread
- 10. A Lemon Drizzle Cake
- 11. 4 Decorated Cup Cakes
- 12. Ladies' only Victoria Sponge (3 eggs, any jam or lemon curd, caster sugar on top)
- 13. 4 Flapjacks
- 14. 4 Scones
- 15. 4 Biscuits (any type)
- 16. 4 Shortbreads
- 17. Men's only Cake (no help!) Please write on a card the type of cake entered.
- 18. Homemade Pork Pie

*Judging:* The judges will be tasting as well as looking and checking if the exhibits are sufficiently cooked.

#### FLOWERS SECTION - 15 CLASSES

Section rules: \* All flowers exhibited must be home grown, except for classes 28, 29, 30, & 33, for which flowers etc may be bought. \* Exhibitors provide their own containers.

*Judging:* Judges will be looking at the form, freshness & condition of the flowers and leaves, size & colour, in that order of priority

#### **VEGETABLES SECTION - 20 CLASSES**

# **Section rules:** \* All exhibited vegetables must be grown by the exhibitor and displayed on plates, shallow bowls, or baskets as appropriate.

- 34. Oddest Shaped Vegetable (can be any un-doctored vegetable)
- 35. 3 Carrots (trim tops to 75mm/3 inches)

- 51. 3 Vegetables that can be used in a salad either raw or cooked
- 52. Any other pair of Vegetable not in above list (e.g. 2 pumpkins, 2 gourds etc.)
- 53. My Best Vegetable and My Best Flower (one only of each)

*Judging:* Judges will be looking for good condition, uniformity where more than 1 vegetable is displayed, size, shape & colour, in that order of priority

#### Section rules: \*All fruit must have been grown by the exhibitor.
