03.25.08 Play area/Teenage facilities

Prices are locked in. 8 weeks from order placement, work commencing possibly first week of June, avoiding half term. 2-3 weeks completion with payment 14 days after completion. Articles will be put in SAL, Facebook and on the website in May advising that changes will be taking place and that parts of the playground will be closed at some stage.

The blockage in the toilet has been fixed, and was partly caused by toilet paper and blue towels from the S&R and partly due to tree roots and debris further down the drain run. **ML to investigate the terms of the lease as to whose responsibility the drains are for future reference**.

There will be some S106 funds available after the playground refurbishment. It was agreed to aim to use this for refurbishment of Pocket Park. The precept in future years will need to reflect future investment in equipment for both playgrounds. The possibility of adult exercise equipment was discussed.

03.25.09 Blandford Fly project

The next few months will be used to capture useful data and raise awareness about treatment options whilst the flies are at their most acute.
